Day 1: Hanoi Arrival – Hanoi Sightseeing Tour (D, G)

Arrive at Noi Bai International Airport, welcome by our guide and transfer to your hotel. The transfer distance is approximately 40 minutes. Check in hotel at 14:00.

Afternoon, you will visit the **Ho Chi Minh Complex** includes Ba Dinh square, the President Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (closed on Monday and Friday, every afternoon, we can still view from the outside the building), a sightseeing of the Presidential Palace (view from outside), President's Fishpond, House on Stilts, and the famous One Pillar Pagoda. **Tran Quoc Pagoda** - the oldest Buddhist temple in Hanoi, is located on a small island near the southeastern shore of Hanoi's West Lake, Vietnam.

Stopping at **Hoan Kiem Lake**, start for a walking tour through the fame Hanoi Old Quarters known for its '36 streets of 36 wares' named after the original 36 artisan guilds that date as far back as the 13th century.

Have dinner and overnight in Hanoi.

Day 2: Hanoi – Sapa by bus, Cat Cat Village, Sapa Church (B, L, D G)

Morning, our bus will pick you up at hotel then transfer (about 5.5hour driving) to Lao Cai via Hanoi Lao Cai Highways – the Vietnam's longest expressway, cutting travel time in half to Sa Pa.

You will have lunch at local restaurant then check in hotel and take a short rest.

Afternoon, first stop you will visit **Sapa Church** before take a short car ride just 3 km out of Sa Pa to **Cat Cat village** inhabited by a community of Hmong ethnic minority people. The village is known as a cultural site since many traditions and customs of the Black Hmong are still preserved to date. The traditional trades of brocade making and silver and bronze smith are still practiced nowadays by villagers after numerous generations of their ancestors. You can see the Hmong women by their looms weaving fabrics, which will be later on dyed with sap from leaves for the desired coloration. Your walk

through the village will take you to **Tien Sa waterfall** (Silver Waterfall) where a French-built hydropower station has been in service since 1920.

Dinner at local restaurant. After dinner time, free time to explore night market in Sapa. Overnight at hotel in Sapa

Day 3: Fansipan Mountain – Bus to Hanoi (B, L, D, G)

After breakfast at hotel, you're picked up then transfer from Sapa town to Fansipan cable car station. Visit **Fansipan Mountain by the cable car**. Enjoy the view from the highest point of this incredible mountain. The lush green and subtropical vegetation makes this mountain really very beautiful. You will have free time to take some pictures for unforgettable experience from the top.

Lunch at local restaurant.

Afternoon, take transfer back to Hanoi by bus. Have dinner and overnight in Hanoi City.

12:30 – 14:00 Savor a premium lunch while Ambassador Cruise passes by famous beautiful landscapes in Halong Bay.

13:00 – 14:00 Enjoy tea and coffee at the restaurant.

14:00 – 15:00 Discover Luon Cave – one of the most unique caves in Halong Bay featuring the self-contained lake inside a closed arch-shaped mountain, where you can experience sitting on a bamboo boat* rowed by a local or Kayaking*.

15:00 – 16:00 Indulge in fascinating live band music at the Sundecks (except on every Monday) and admire the magical scenery of Halong Bay. You can opt to enjoy the cooking class at the 4th-floor restaurant.

16:00 – 16:30 Check out at the reception on the first deck while cruising back to the harbour.

16:30 – 17:00 Disembark at Halong International Cruise Port. Transfer back Hanoi city.

Dinner and overnight in Hanoi city.

- + Dong Ba market: The biggest commercial center of Hue city. All of the most special cultural gifts and souvenirs can be found in Dong Ba market

Enjoy the lunch at local restaurant with Hue specialty cakes.

After that we're continue to visit the emperors Tomb, conical hat village and incense stick making village.

- + Khai Dinh tomb: The tomb of emperor Khai Dinh (1885-1925) the 12th King of Nguyen dynasty.
- + Conical hat village: To see and learn how the locals make the conical hat (non la). (Non-la- traditional indispensable accessory expressing the hidden charm and simplicity of women).
- + Incense stick making village: Observe how locals make sandalwood and cinnamon incense

4:00pm – 4:30 pm: End the trip, transfer to Da Nang City, Have Dinner and overnight in Da Nang City.

Day 6: Bana Hill – Golden Bridge – Fantasy Park (B, L, D, G)

8:00: We'll come to pick you up from your hotel in Hoi An and then make our way to the breathtaking Ba Na Hills. Start your day by checking in at the Suoi Mo Cable Car Station, where you'll board a cable car and enjoy stunning views of the surrounding mountains as you make your way to Marseille Station.

Once you arrive at Marseille Station, you'll have the opportunity to visit the famous Golden Bridge. This stunning pedestrian bridge is held up by two giant stone hands and offers breathtaking views of the surrounding hills and forests.

Head to Jardin D'Amour, a beautiful garden filled with colorful flowers, fountains, and sculptures. Take a leisurely stroll through the garden and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere.

Next, you'll visit the Linh Ung Pagoda, a Buddhist temple known for its impressive statue of the Goddess of Mercy.

After all that sightseeing, it's time to have a delicious lunch at a local Vietnamese buffet restaurant with over 70 Vietnamese culinary items. Try some of the local specialties and enjoy the flavors of Vietnam.

Spend your afternoon at Fantasy Park, an amusement park with more 150 rides, games, and attractions. Whether you're a thrill-seeker or prefer something more relaxed, there'll be exciting activities for your family at Fantasy Park.

You'll end your day by exploring the fantastic view of Ba Na Hills from King Peak at an altitude of 1.487m. Return to the Cable Car Station and the Gateway, and our guide will transfer you for dinner at Indian Restaurant before back to the hotel. Overnight in Da Nang City.

Note: The ticket includes round-trip cable car rides as well as visits to impressive landmarks such as the Golden Bridge, Fantasy Park, and Moon Castle (ticket not includes the wax museum, Debay wine cellar, and several games)

Day 7: Da Nang City - Cam Thanh Village – Hoi An City (B, L, D, G)

After breakfast, beginning the day with an excursion to Da Nang City.

Our van will transfer you to Monkey Mountain. A giant statue of Lady Buddha with a beautiful background such as mountains and a huge garden of bonsai would draw your attention.

- Discovery the Marble Mountains and stop for a walk along the site to see local factories of stone sculptures - the most impressive handicrafts village in Da Nang.
- Check in the Marble Mountains by climbing up to the top (elevator is optional). Here we will see beautiful pagodas which were made in the 19th century by the last dynasty of the VietNam monarchy, and visit Huyền Không or Tàng Chơn caves.
- Keep going to see the biggest fascinating cave named as Âm Phủ cave. You will learn interesting philosophies of Buddhism and take photos with amazing natural creations.
- Have lunch at Indian restaurant.

Afternoon, continue transfer to Cam Thanh village, being a fisherman at Cam Thanh water coconut village tour you will enjoy experiences from learning traditional fishing techniques and how to row unique Vietnamese bamboo basket boat, fishing and catch the crabs, coconut mussel while exploring the now tranquil coconut-palm flanked waterways of a past war.

Then to **Hoi An** for a walking tour to discover the charm of Hoi An as a renowned World Heritage Site. Besides visiting must-see highlights of the Old Town such as the town's iconic 400-year-old Covered Bridge, the Museum of Trade Ceramics, the 200-year-old Tan Ky House, our knowledgeable guide will take you through lesser-known paths, crisscross through the maze of shortcuts, narrow passages and back alleys that are less travelled for a more engaging and personal experience.

Close the trip, free time for shopping around Hoi An Old Quarter before dinner, transfer back hotel, overnight in Da Nang city.

Have breakfast then transfer to Noi Bai airport for flight to Saigon City.

You will be picked up at the Tan Son Nhat International Airport with our private air-conditioned vehicle to transfer to the hotel for check-in (Normally check in time is 14:00, early check in will depend to hotel available). Lunch a local restaurant.

Afternoon, take a city tour to visit outside Saigon Notre-Dame Basilica a neo-Roman cathedral built by the colonial French with materials entirely imported from Marseilles (It is renovating until 2022). Discover the magnificent neo-Romanesque architecture as you take in the tranquil atmosphere inside. At the opposite Central Post Office, one of the oldest buildings in Ho Chi Minh City, learn about this significant landmark — the busiest post office in Vietnam. Admire the neoclassical-style of the post office interior as your guide points out the painted maps of former Saigon, once the capital of South Vietnam. Continue visit Giac Lam Pagoda – The oldest pagoda in Saigon.

Last but not least, we will visit Cho Lon area or the city's China Town and the Jade Emperor Temple (Phuoc Hai), a rare Taoist structure in Vietnam built by the Cantonese community in the area in 1909.

Dinner at local restaurant and overnight in Saigon.

Switch back to a motorboat to go to a bee farm to enjoy fresh honey tea and fresh fruits. On the way back to My Tho, stop to visit **Vinh Trang Pagoda**, a prominent local Buddhist structure built in 1850 with a unique architectural mixture of Vietnamese, Roman, Chinese and Cambodian styles characterized by a highly ornate façade. Back to Saigon. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight at hotel in Saigon.

Day 11: Ho Chi Minh Departure (B, G)

Have breakfast at hotel, then free time until guide pick up to airport for flight back your country. End the trip.
